BANKSETA

- Micro-lending Frontline Service NQF Level: 3 – Equips learners with tools to function as a micro finance officer in MFI including various aspects involved in loan cycle.
- Core Banking and Financial Services NQF Level: 4 – Focuses on financial product sales, services and financial analysis and credit application suitable for existing clients wanting to expand their skills within the financial environment.
- Credit and Risk Assessment NQF Level: 5 – An important part of any registered credit provider in South Africa, the qualification encourages lenders to apply focus on credit and risk assessments.
- Sales and Customer Relations NQF Level: 5 – Teaches learners aspects of customer relations and skills to implement successful sales strategies.

- National Certificate: Financial Markets and Instruments treasury NQF LEVEL 6 – Assists learners with understanding specialised financial instruments, investments and risk measures within the market.
- Banking Service Advice NQF level 5 – Provides learners with the requirements of the regulations under FAIS Act, enabling them to offer financial skills to clients within the banking sector.
- National Certificate Generic management – Suitable for managers who have other junior managers reporting to them or person-managing first line of managers within an organisation.

- Long-Term Insurance NQF Level 4 – Helps learners understand the long-term sub-sector within context of the financial services Industry.
- Short-Term Insurance Level 4 – Nationally recognised and suitable for both new and long-service employees within the short-term insurance industry and ensuring learners are FIAS Fit.
- Retail Insurance NQF Level 4 – Provides learners with fundamental understanding of concepts and principles required within retail insurance industry.
- Wealth Management Level 4 – Suitable for learners with basic understanding of economics, asset management and investment principles. Provides learners with an introduction to wealth creation and management.
- National Certificate Wealth Management Level 5 – Provides an understanding of economics principles.

IRMSA
